#### Privacy Policy of the German Society for Crystallography regarding personal member data

A detailed and up-to-date version of the data protection declaration concerning all internet activities of the German Society for Crystallography can be found on the website of the DGK at http://dgk-home.de/intern/web-seiten-der-dgk/datenschutz/. The data protection declaration printed here concerns personal member data as collected when a member registers with the German Society of Crystallography.

When a member joins, the DGK records the personal data of the joining member as listed in the application form. This information is stored in the computer systems of the board. Each member of the association is assigned a membership number.

The personal data is protected from third party access by appropriate technical and organisational measures. Other information about members and non-members will only be processed or used by the association if it is useful for the promotion of the association's purpose and there are no indications that the person concerned has an interest worthy of protection which opposes the processing or use.

Special events in the life of the association shall be publicised in press releases, the association's magazine, on the DGK's website and by e-mail to the members of the DGK. Personal member data may be published in the process. The individual member may object to such publication of his or her data at any time. In this case, no further publication shall take place with regard to this member.

Only members of the Executive Committee and other members who exercise a special function in the Association which requires knowledge of certain member data shall be given a list of members with the required member data. This also applies to third parties commissioned by the DGK to carry out the activities described in the statutes. The third parties commissioned by the DGK are obliged to protect personal data and are only authorised to use the data insofar as this is necessary for the provision of the offer or service.

Upon resignation, the member's data will be deleted from the membership register. Personal data of the resigning member concerning the treasury administration shall be kept for up to ten years from the written confirmation of the resignation by the Executive Board in accordance with the provisions of tax law.
